SANDUSKY COUNTY BOARD OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES HOSTS PHASE 1A COVID VACCINE CLINIC FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

Sandusky County Public Health vaccinates over 150 'at-risk' individuals at the Sandusky County Board of DD this week.

The Sandusky County Board of DD hosted two Phase 1 A vaccination clinics for local individuals with developmental disabilities and staff living or working in congregate settings.

SCBDD Superintendent Sarah Zimmerman shared, *"We are really excited to see individuals receive the vaccination. Their staff also need to be vaccinated because they take care of individuals 24 hours a day, seven days a week and have a lot of exposure with them. It's a great feeling to finally get started. It brings hope."*

Sandusky County Board of DD Service and Support Administrators organized the clinic; reaching out to individuals on their respective caseloads and scheduling those who were eligible to receive their vaccine.

This first Phase 1-A vaccination was made possible and administered by Sandusky County Public Health.

"We would like to thank the Sandusky County Health Department for partnering with us to protect the most vulnerable in our community. The nursing staff at the health department were so warm, caring, and patient. We look forward to coordinating and hosting additional vaccine clinics with the Health Department in the weeks ahead," said Zimmerman.
